What we do: Volunteer work crews come to Rockford each summer and help homeowners to make their homes warmer, safer and drier. In the past we have done drywall repairs, painting, building of handicap ramps, stair and deck repair/replacement and porch repairs.

How it works: Eligibility is based on age, income, disability or special circumstances. Once your application has been reviewed, and you are found eligible, we will schedule a visit to evaluate repairs. We encourage you to apply if you need help. 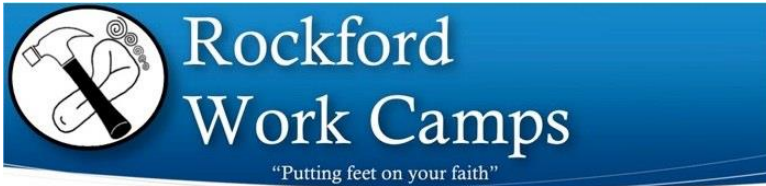

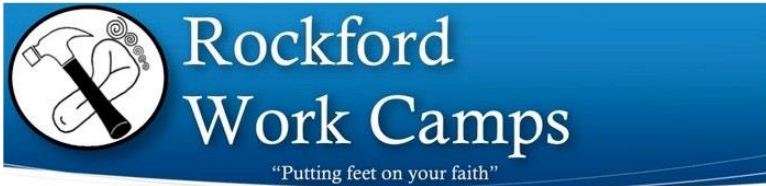
